



Philosophy of Christian Service at Christ the King School

Christ the King Catholic School is dedicated to educating the whole person. Because we believe that every person is sacred, and that Christ called us to a life of service to others, Christ the King Catholic School requires students to perform service throughout the school year.

Service Requirements

- Eighth Grade students are to perform at least four (4) hours of Christian service per quarter.
- Seventh Grade students will perform a minimum of three (3) service hours per quarter.
- Students in the Sixth grade are to perform no fewer than two (2) hours of Christian service each quarter.

Students *may* accomplish service requirements during the previous summer. However, if a student completes all hours for a given semester, year, or even the entire junior high career, a minimum number of hours *must* be completed each semester to support their work in Religion class.

These requirements are designed to prepare students for a life dedicated to Christian service and are consistent with guidelines established by our Archdiocesan High Schools.

Practicalities

Service opportunities are posted in the Junior High Religion classroom, and will be announced elsewhere from time to time. Students *must* complete the attached form to document each service project. The forms are available from the Junior High Religion teacher and are posted on the school web site.
