Mission

Our mission is to nurture positive Catholic values in young people and to provide campers a community of faith and fun in a safe environment. We promote the personal and spiritual growth in each young person by developing their prayer life, social skills, independence, and respect for others.

Age Limits

Any youth who has finished the 3rd grade through the 12th. There is no great concern whether they are going into or coming out of one or the other grades. Non-Catholic friends are welcome. Campers are not allowed to leave camp and return during their camping session. A written permission is required if campers leave with someone other than a parent/guardian at the end of camp.

Staff

The counselors are college students and high school juniors and seniors who love camp! All camp staff members are screened and have completed the Archdiocesan Safe Environment Training. You will have a chance to meet the counselors when you drive your child to camp. Joining us during camp to share their faith will be priests, seminarians, young adults and adults who work with youth who are also screened and trained in Safe Environment.

Meals

We will have a full staff working in the kitchen preparing delicious camp food for all the campers. Three full meals plus two snacks are provided daily. Please do not send food, money, or valuables with your camper or in their mail. Mail is delivered daily to campers. To insure prompt delivery, mail must be hand-carried to camp at the time of the camper's arrival.

Activities

There are crafts, hiking, swimming (in ground pool), fishing, water sports, volleyball, canoeing, archery, scripture adventures, talent show, soccer, campfires, drama and more.
